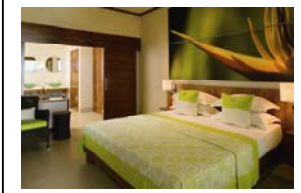


The décor is strikingly attractive, with pure, simple lines contrasting with bright green touches on the bedspreads, on the large image of a paradise bird above the headboard and elsewhere in the room.

Standard rooms have queen-size beds (1m80 by 2m) or twin beds (1m par 2m). The bed cover has been specially designed for the hotel.

A sliding, wooden door opens up to reveal a spacious bathroom, bathed in natural light. As well as a corner bath, there is a separate shower cubicle edged in sintered-glass tiling, 2 washbowls on stands and lots of wardrobe space.

The solid wood, used for all the doors and many of the fittings, gives a warm, rich feel to both rooms.



Standard Room

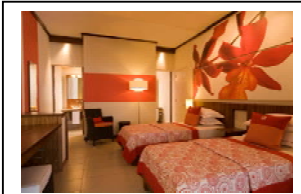
72 Superior Rooms (46 m² including the terrace)



Warm, sunny colours envelop the room. The décor is uncluttered, with clean, contemporary lines offset here by touches of red orange.

An image of a huge, orange orchid stands above the wooden headboard and the touches of red orange in the curtains and the uniquely designed bedcover are invigorating.

The bathroom has a bath, two glass washbasins, a separate shower edged with decorated sintered-glass tiling, separate toilets and a spacious wardrobe.



Superior Room

24 Deluxe Rooms (49 m² including the terrace)

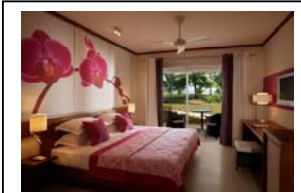


The orchid feature again predominates above the headboard of the queen size bed of (2m by 1.80m), but this time shades of fuchsia are featured throughout to create a dramatic effect.

In the bathroom, there are two bowl-shaped white porcelain basins which sit on a golden taupe marble. There is also sintered-glass Bizzassa tiling in the shower which comes from Italy, is brightened by the light coming from the three windows. The large bath has marble surrounds and is set in its own corner.

There is a space created in the rooms by the clever interior design, so that even from the shower, there are views beyond the bedroom and the terrace to the sea & garden.

Kiatt, a wood from North Africa, is used throughout all the rooms. The clean, contemporary lines of the basic décor, offset here by the warmth of natural wood and the touches of fuchsia colour, are simply stunning

Restaurants & Bars

Main Restaurant - Show

Seats 300

(7 a.m -10.30 a.m. and 7. p.m. - 10.30 p.m.)

Beams of light from gobos (What is a Gobo) illuminate the pure, contemporary lines of the interior where shades of orange merge into rounded lines and cubic shapes. The main restaurant is divided into three and has three open kitchens. The main restaurant offers a range of international cuisine, with buffet breakfasts, "a la carte" lunches and buffet dining.

Beach Restaurant and Bar - Playa

Seats 65

(12.30 p.m. - 4 p.m. and 7.30 p.m. - 10.30 p.m.)

This is the place to relax with your feet in the sand, watching the sea, having a hearty salad lunch or enjoying the Latin cuisine. The dinner menu varies from themed evenings to buffets and "a la carte."

Lounge Bar - B-Bar

Seats 150

(12.30 p.m. - 4 p.m. and 7.30 p.m. - 10.30 p.m.)

The main bar is split-level, with a unique décor combining contemporary and traditional touches.

The wooden bar counter is at table-height and the bar itself is surrounded by large, comfortable armchairs.

White and turquoise predominate in the colour scheme, offset by wood, steel and glass fittings, to create a feeling of warm, contemporary elegance.

From the ceiling, globes of light add to the subtle atmosphere and reflect in the ivory-coloured flooring, studded with bluish decorative tiling.

The Lounge Bar offers a selection of cocktails, rums, beers and spirits of international brands.

Well-Being and Leisure

Water Sports

3 swimming pools

Free of charge: windsurfing, pedal boats, kayaks, aqua gym, sailing, snorkeling, glass bottom boat rides and water-skiing.

For a fee: speedboat rides, diving (PADI) and deep-sea fishing

Land-based Activities

Free of charge: Gym, beach volley, stretching classes, table tennis, bocci ball and 2 floodlit tennis courts.

For a fee: Mountain bikes, billiards and game machines.

There is an 18-hole golf course next to the hotel

Spa

Gentle shades of green and khaki blend harmoniously with the wood and the surrounding greenery.

The spa has 16 treatment rooms (14 double), a 12m long pool, a hot tub, a sauna, a hammam, two changing rooms, a hairdressing parlour and a beauty salon which provide beauty care and massage.

The double treatment rooms (17m²) all have a private garden outside.

Kids and Teens

Kids Club

A circular building houses the Kids Club, which is next to the tennis courts. It has a large amphitheatre-shaped space for shows, a dining room on the terrace, 2 internet-access screens, a sandpit and a rest room. The Club is for children between 3 and 12.

The kids are looked after by qualified staffs who organize activities from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. each day. A baby sitting service is available on request (with supplement).

Teens Club

The Teens club, for older youngsters, has games machines, a billiard table and table football.

Conference Room

The air-conditioned conference room can hold 80 people seated cinema-style.

Standard audio-visual material is available free-of-charge to hotel guests and includes a 35mm slide projector, an overhead projector, a video and cassette system, a DVD player, microphone, a flip chart, a video projector, a lectern and a wall-mounted screen.

Other equipment can be obtained on request (with supplement).
