

Victoria Falls Add-on

Why not tag on a side trip to one of the seven natural wonders of the world ?

ZAMBIA



As well as flights from Johannesburg it is also possible to combine a visit to Victoria Falls with a safari in Botswana; with a visit to Namibia; or on one of the regular Rovos Rail luxury rail itineraries, starting in Pretoria.



Day 1-2

Take one of the regular daily flights from Johannesburg to Livingstone in Zambia. On arrival you will be met and transferred, by road, to your hotel or lodge for your 2-night stay.

There are plenty of different ways to see the magnificent Victoria Falls – on a guided walking tour, taking you through the rain forest and to viewing sights; a cruise on the Zambezi; or in a light aircraft giving you a real birds-eye view. This area is also well known as an activity centre, offering some real adrenalin rushes – white-water rafting; microlighting; bungee jumping; river boarding; tandem kayaking; abseiling (face first if preferred); and finally the gorge swing ! But that's not all – horse trails, elephant back safaris, traditional vehicle safaris, river cruises, cultural tours and shopping trips are all available.

Tongabezi is a unique lodge on the banks of the Zambezi River, just upstream from the Victoria Falls. There is a wide range of activities available, many included in the rate. The five River Cottages are situated along the river bank, and additionally there are four 'houses', each with sweeping views over the Zambezi River.

Sindabezi Island Camp sleeps ten people, in five rustic open fronted thatched chalets. There is no electricity, just wood fires and hot bucket showers on demand. Sindabezi is ideal for a small party looking for complete privacy, and taking the whole island ensures a private guide, boat and vehicle.

The Falls Resort is situated in the 46-hectare Mosi-Oa-Tunya National Wildlife Park, which fringes the Zambezi River, and incorporates the 3-star Zambezi Sun and the 5-star Royal Livingstone Hotel. The Zambezi Sun is located on the edge of the Eastern Cataract of the Victoria Falls. For the traveller in search of luxury the Royal Livingstone Hotel is set in the lush riverine belt on the banks of the Zambezi River. The Resort incorporates an Activity Centre where advice is available on a variety of excursions and safaris.

Day 3

After an action packed couple of days transfer back to the airport for your return flight to Johannesburg.
