Day 1 - Daily Departures

Overnight flight from London Heathrow to Cape Town

Day 2 - 5

On arrival into Cape Town International Airport collect your group 'A' Avis rental car, and using the detailed directions provided, make your way to [Redbourne Hilldrop](#) or similar for your four night stay. If you prefer we can arrange for you to be met and transferred to your guest house, and the car to be delivered at your convenience.

Enjoy the attractions of one of the worlds most spectacular cities, including Table Mountain; V & Waterfront, Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens; Cape of Good Hope; Robben Island, and many more.

Day 6 - 7

An hours drive this morning will bring you to the heart of the Winelands. Stellenbosch is the second oldest town in South Africa and the centre of the largest and most varied wine route in South Africa. During your two night stay at [Caledon Villa](#) or similar in this historic town, enjoy any one of the 75 restaurants or head to a wine estate for a cellar tour and tasting.



Other options include a stop at the Cape South Coast; a prolonged trip along 'Route 62'; Jeffrey's Bay (for surfers); or continue up the Cape Wild Coast.

Day 8 - 9

Head east along the scenic 'Route 62' to the heart of the Klein Karoo and Oudtshoorn, the Ostrich capital of South Africa, for a further two night stay at [Oue Werf Guest Farm](#) or similar. From here you can visit the Cango Caves, an Ostrich farm or drive over one of the most spectacular mountain passes in Africa, the Swartberg Pass, to the delightful Karoo town of Prince Albert - not for the faint hearted.

Day 10 - 13

An enjoyable four-hour drive will take you to one of the most popular areas of the Garden Route, Knysna, for your four-night stay at [Waterfront Lodge](#) or similar. The near-by town of Plettenberg Bay has great swimming beaches. Tsitsikamma National Park, Nature's Valley and Storm's River Mouth are close by, or just relax and soak up the peace and quiet of this charming town & stunning area.

Day 14 - 15

Today drive through the Tsitsikamma Forest and beyond Port Elizabeth to the Eastern Cape. From here you have a variety of game viewing and safari options to choose from - private game reserves, country house hotels and retreats or a bed & breakfast establishment. Any of these options will give you access to the thrill of big five game viewing in this non-malarial area of South Africa. Enjoy a two night stay at [The Stable Cottages](#) near Addo Elephant National Park.

Day 16

Drop your car at Port Elizabeth Airport before your flight back to London Heathrow via Johannesburg.

Day 17

Arrive early this morning into London Heathrow.
