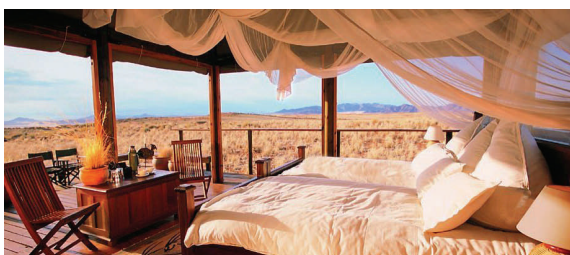


Namibia Highlights Self-Drive Itinerary



If you enjoy driving, this itinerary will take you to the highlights of Namibia. It combines the worlds highest sand dunes & the adventure and ocean at Swakopmund. Search for desert adapted elephants, see the Twyfelfontein rock engravings, view the animals in Etosha and admire the conservation work at Okonjima.

Other options include continuing North to the Caprivi Strip and / or combining the Victoria Falls, Botswana or South Africa.

Day 1 - Friday
Overnight flight from London Heathrow to Windhoek, Namibia, with South African Airways.

Day 2 - Saturday
On arrival at Hosea Kutako International Airport collect your vehicle and head for Windhoek and an overnight stay at [Olive Grove Guest House](#) or similar. Our local representative will give you your documentation and debriefing.

Day 3 - Sunday
Your next destination is Bagatelle Kalahari Game Ranch, a five-hour drive from Windhoek, for an overnight stay amid the huge red sand dunes of the Southern Kalahari.

Day 4 - 5 - Monday / Tuesday
Built amongst impressive granite boulders near the Fish River Canyon is [Canon Lodge](#) or similar, approximately 20km from the main viewpoint and your home for the next two nights.

Day 6 - 7 - Wednesday / Thursday
Your destination for the evening is The Nest Hotel or similar, in the picturesque coastal town of Luderitz. An optional activity is to visit the nearby famous Ghost Town of Kolmanskop.

Day 8 - 9 - Friday / Saturday
Spend two nights at Desert [Homestead](#) or similar in Sossusvlei region.

Day 10 - 11 - Sunday / Monday
Continue to Swakopmund for a two night stay at The Cornerstone Guesthouse or similar. Use this as a base for desert and coastal activities and scenic flights over the remarkable Skeleton Coast.

Day 12 - 13 - Tuesday / Wednesday
Today you will arrive at Camp Kipwe, which boasts magnificent desert scenery, a unique variety of desert flora and fauna

and fascinating geological formations, where you will stay for two nights.

Day 14 - 17 - Thursday / Sunday
After breakfast travel north to [Anderssons Camp](#) in the Central Etosha region, where you will spend two nights. After Ongava travel through Etosha National Park to [Mushara Lodge](#) or similar for two nights. Activities at either lodge include nature walks, game drives and excursions into Etosha National Park.

Day 18 - Monday
On the road again, travelling South, to [Okonjima Main Lodge](#), home to the AfriCat Foundation which aims to conserve and protect threatened wild cat species such as cheetah and leopard. Guests have the opportunity to see the programme at work and learn more about these beautiful animals.

Day 19 - Tuesday
Head back to Windhoek today and drop your car, before your overnight flight back to London Gatwick.

Day 20 - Wednesday
Arrive early this morning into London Gatwick.
