Mauritius doesn't only offer wonderful beaches and resorts, the interior region and the towns & villages are interesting, sometimes exotic and always perfectly safe. Rent a car and drive yourself or go on an organized excursion to - Black River Gorge National Park with its jungle and bird life (the rare Pink Pigeon, Echo Parakeet and Mauritius Kestrel), walking-tours and Alexander Waterfalls; Pamplemousses Botanical Gardens, with hundreds of tropical plant species;

Grand Bassin, a sacred lake for the Hindus in the Black River Gorge National Park, worth a visit particularly when the feast of Maha Shivaratree is celebrated; Domaine du Chasseur, a colonial era plantation and nature reserve; or the crowded, loud and colourful capital city of Port Louis.

Other activities include scenic helicopter flights, a Submarine Safari, full and half day catamaran cruises and trips to nearby islands.
