

# Namibia Visions fly-in Safari

*A 9-day luxury fly-in safari staying in lodges situated in some of the most pristine areas of Namibia*



**WINDHOEK > ETOSHA > DAMARALAND / TWYFELFONTEIN > NAMIBRAND NATURE RESERVE**

## Day 1

On arrival at Hosea Kutako International Airport you will be met and transferred to Olive Grove Guesthouse in Windhoek for an overnight stay. You will have the afternoon at leisure to laze around the pool or do some sightseeing around Windhoek.

## Day 2

This morning you will be transferred to Eros airport for your charter flight to the Okuti airstrip in Etosha National Park. From there transfer to Onguma Tented Camp for a 2-night stay. The camp is on the eastern boundary of Etosha. Enjoy an afternoon activity on the 20 000 hectare private reserve.

## Day 3

Spend a day (or morning) game viewing in Etosha National Park and enjoy a sundowner drive at Onguma on your return.

## Day 4

Back to the airstrip this morning for your onward flight to Damaraland, landing at noon. Mowani Mountain Camp, your home for the next 2 nights, is in the Twyfelfontein Conservancy between the Ugab and Huab rivers. This afternoon there is an excursion to the rock engravings at Twyfelfontein, returning to the camp for sundowners and dinner.



*Other options include an optional day excursion scenic flight (on day 7) to Fish River Canyon, Luderitz, Kolmanskop and back to Wolwedans along the Diamond Coast and over Spencer Bay & Mercury Island; or do the optional day excursion (day 4) to Ruacana and a traditional Himba village to view the ways of this fascinating nomadic tribe, then on to Epupa Falls before returning to Mowani.*

## Day 5

Spend the day exploring the surrounding area and in the afternoon join a game drive in search of the rare Desert elephants.

## Day 6

Your charter flight will today take you to the coastal town of Swakopmund, and time permitting a city tour or activity may be done. You then continue on the exceptionally scenic flight to the NamibRand Nature Reserve, circling over the towering dunes of Sossusvlei on your way to Wolwedans. Arrive in time for sundowners and a dinner under the stars at Wolwedans Dune Lodge, your home for the next 3 nights.

## Day 7

Depart on a full day safari to the NamibRand Nature Reserve with a picnic lunch served en route.

## Day 8

Enjoy a morning and/or afternoon excursion or a morning walk. Or an early morning ballooning trip with champagne breakfast may fit in well today. Alternatively, relax on this the last full day of your safari.

## Day 9

After breakfast take your 09h00 DuneHopper air-taxi back to Windhoek, arriving at approx. 11h00.
