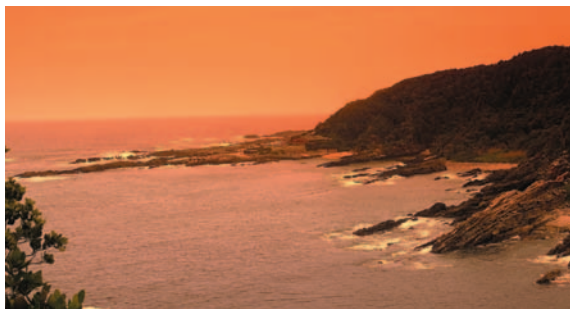
## Day 1-4

On arrival into Cape Town International Airport collect your AVIS rental car, and using the detailed directions provided, make your way to your first Portfolio establishment for your 4-night stay. If you prefer we can arrange for you to be met and transferred to the hotel, and the car can be delivered at your convenience.

Enjoy the attractions of one of the worlds most spectacular cities, including Table Mountain; V&A Waterfront; Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens; Cape of Good Hope; Robben Island, and many more.

## Day 5-6

An hours drive this morning will bring you to the heart of the winelands. Stellenbosch is the second oldest town in South Africa and the centre of the largest and most varied wine route in South Africa. During your 2-night stay in this historic town enjoy any one of the 75 restaurants in the town or head to a wine estate for a cellar tour and tasting.



*Other options include a stop at the Cape South Coast; a prolonged trip along 'Route 62'; Jeffrey's Bay (for surfers); or continue up the Cape Wild Coast.*

## Day 7-8

Head east along the scenic 'Route 62' to the heart of the Klein Karoo and Oudtshoorn, the Ostrich capital of South Africa, for a further 2-night stay. From here you can visit the Cango Caves, an Ostrich farm or drive over one of the most spectacular mountain passes in Africa, the Swartberg Pass, to the delightful Karoo town of Prince Albert – not for the fainthearted!

## Day 9-12

An enjoyable 4-hour drive will take you to one of the most beautiful areas of the Garden Route, The Craggs and Nature's Valley, for your 4-night stay. The nearby town of Plettenberg Bay has great swimming beaches. Tsitsikamma National Park and Storm's River Mouth are close by, or just relax and soak up the peace and quiet of this stunning area.

## Day 13-14

Today drive through the Tsitsikamma Forest and beyond Port Elizabeth to the Eastern Cape. From here you have a variety of game viewing and safari options to choose from – private game reserves, country house hotels and retreats or a bed & breakfast establishment. Any of these options will give you access to the thrill of big game viewing in this non-malarial area of South Africa. Enjoy a 2-night stay.

## Day 15

Drop your car at Port Elizabeth, before continuing your journey.
