

Namibia Highlights Self-drive itinerary

If you enjoy driving, this itinerary will take you to the highlights of Namibia. It combines the worlds highest sand dunes & the adventure and ocean at Swakopmund. Search for desert adapted elephants, see the Twyfelfontein rock engravings, view the animals in Etosha and admire the conservation work at Okonjima

Other options include continuing north to the Caprivi Strip and / or combining with Victoria Falls, Botswana or South Africa.

Day 1

On arrival at Hosea Kutako International Airport collect your vehicle and head for Windhoek and an overnight stay at Olive Grove Guesthouse. Our local representative will give you your documentation and debriefing.

Day 2

Your next destination is Bagatelle Kalahari Game Ranch, a 5-hour drive from Windhoek, for an overnight stay amid the huge red sand dunes of the southern Kalahari.

Day 3-4

Built amongst impressive granite boulders near the Fish River Canyon is Canon Lodge, approximately 20km from the main viewpoint and your home for the next 2 nights.

Day 5-6

Your destination for the evening is The Nest Hotel in the picturesque coastal town of Luderitz. An optional activity is to visit the nearby famous Ghost Town of Kolmanskop

Day 7-8

Spend 2 nights at Kulala Desert Lodge / Wilderness Camp in the Sossusvlei region and join in on some of the activities that this wonderful area offers.

Day 9-10

Continue to Swakopmund for a 2 night stay at the Hansa Hotel. Use this as a base for desert and coastal activities and scenic flights over the remarkable Skeleton Coast.

Day 11-12

Today you will arrive at Mowani Mountain Camp, which boasts magnificent desert scenery, a unique variety of desert flora and fauna and fascinating geological formations, where you will stay for 2 nights.

Day 13-16

After breakfast travel north to Ongava Tented Camp in the Central Etosha region, where you will spend 2 nights. After Ongava travel through Etosha National Park to Mushara Lodge for 2 nights. Activities at either lodge include nature walks, game drives and excursions into Etosha National Park.

Day 17

On the road again, travelling south, to Okonjima Lodge, home to the AfriCat Foundation which aims to conserve and protect threatened wild cat species such as cheetah & leopard. Guests have the opportunity to see the programme at work and learn more about these beautiful animals.

Day 18

Head back to Windhoek today and drop your car, before continuing your journey.
